**CATN-II** is an innovative continuing education program intended for experienced Emergency and Critical Care nurses. A case study and critical- thinking approach is utilized. This 13-hour course combines didactic content with interactive discussions, presented in a flexible format. By taking this course, trauma nurses can strengthen their critical decision-making skills to optimally impact the outcome of critically injured or ill patients. The course was developed to reinforce the interlocking psychophysiological concepts central to trauma nursing. Course participants are expected to be familiar with core anatomy and physiology.
